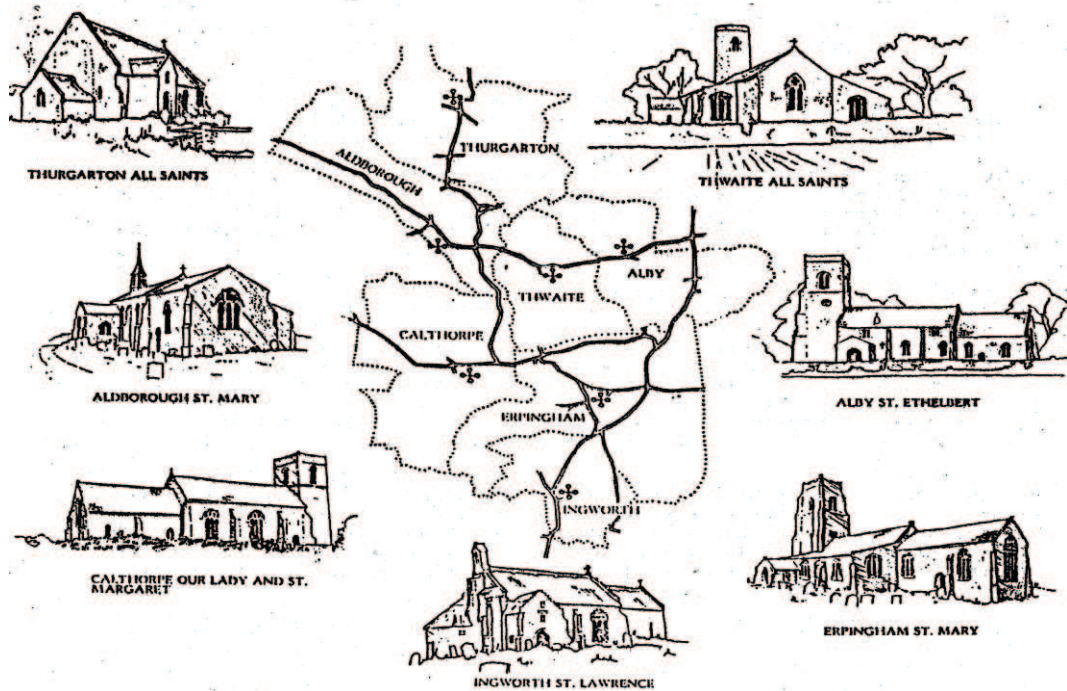

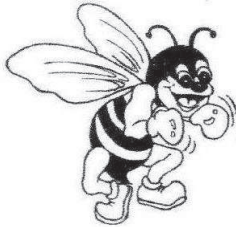

### **ALDBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL**

**Next meeting on Monday 5th July at 7.30** in the Community Centre. At this meeting a decision will be made about the **placing of the Christmas tree**. Please make views known before the meeting.

Items from the minutes of the June meeting (Editor's choice):-

**Matters arising:** Quotations for refurbishment of **noticeboard** and for a replacement **man-hole cover** are still being sought. Remedial work to the Green : estimate of £130 accepted for levelling with topsoil and seeding.

**Replacement of play areas.** HT and SP, with NCC Officers, had met 5 suppliers of playground equipment. Confirmation of grants was still awaited but a letter of intent is expected in July, when an interim payment of £5,000 is likely to be received. Further applications are to be made for grants to assist in provision of equipment for those outside 8 -13 age group. The Parish Council agreed to contribute £1,000 to the replacement of the Play Areas.

**Health & Safety.** Barriers erected round the broken manhole cover had been removed so there was some risk. Welding on one of the swing chairs has broken away : if it cannot be repaired it will be removed.

**Planning.** Plans for the extension of the surgery had been revised to reduce the height of parts of the roof. The Local Development Framework Examination will begin on 20th July.

**Allotments.** One plot vacant, which could be sub-divided. The large compost heap has been removed because of misuse by members of the public.

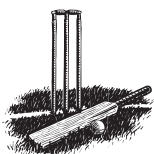
**District Councillor** Peter Willcox reported on detailed proposals for provision of 78 units of affordable housing across North Norfolk by 31 March 2011.

**The Accounts 2009-2010** show a year-end balance of **£6255.47**. Mr Ted Walker of Felbrigg has been appointed as Internal Auditor for the year.
